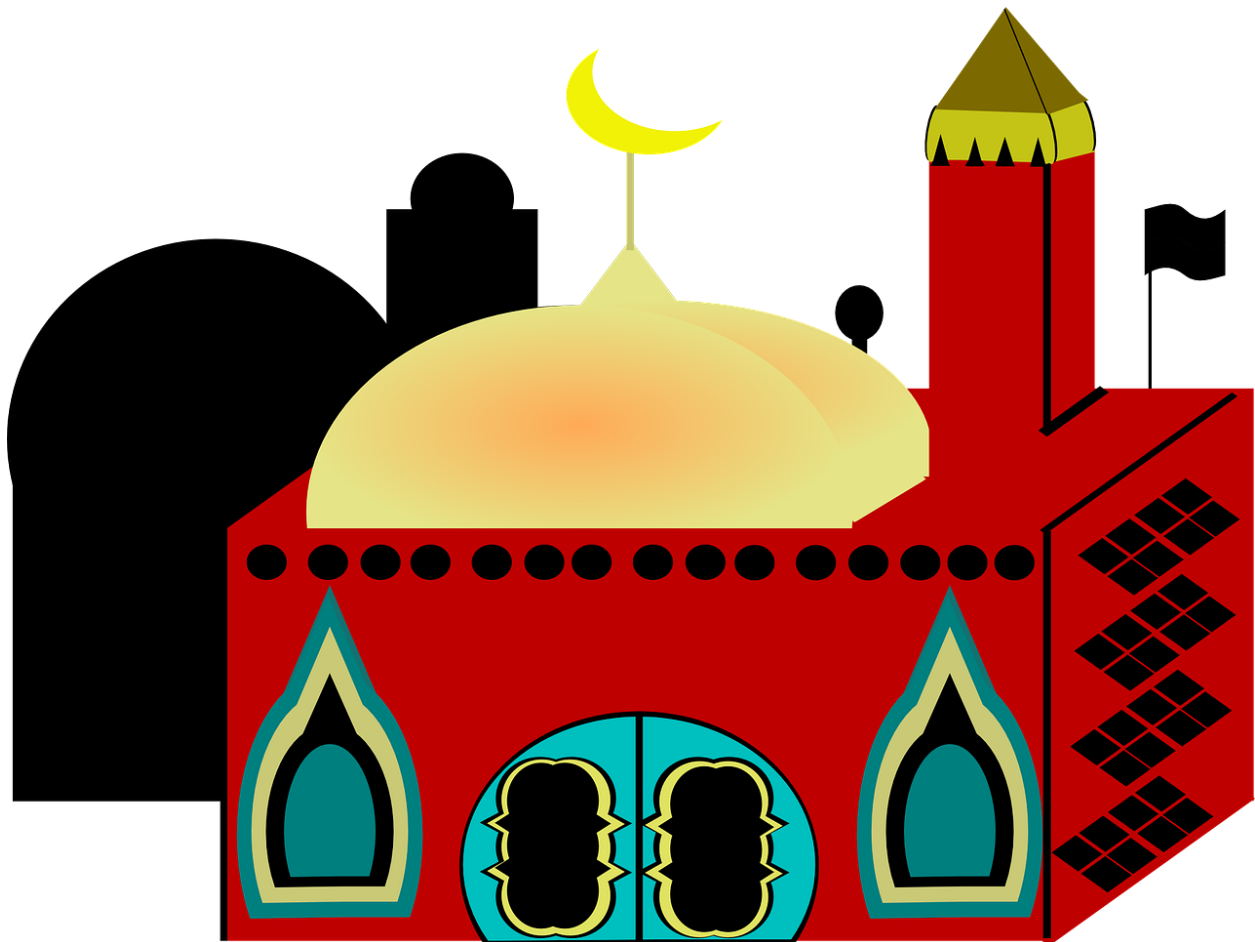




GETTING TO KNOW ALLAH
